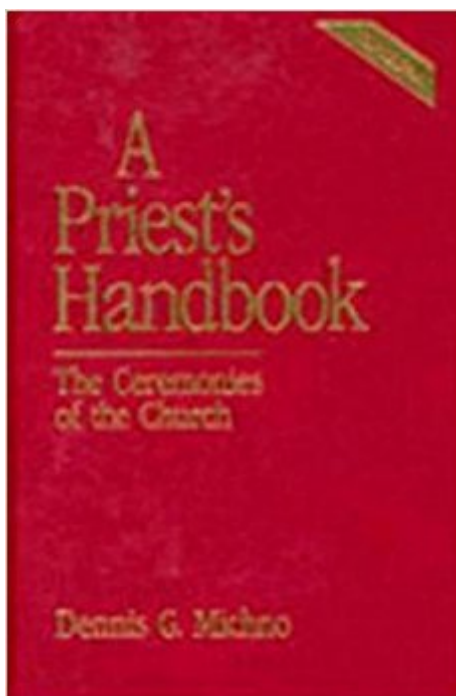


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A Priest's Handbook: The Ceremonies Of The Church (3rd Edition)

Fortunately, wise souls who have gone before us knew better and this outstanding reference was the result. The beauty of our liturgical heritage is preserved when the celebrant is aware fully of his or her duties in each ceremony. "A Priest's Handbook" gives each fledgling priest a vital grounding in the essential elements of presiding over and celebrating the rituals of the Church. More importantly, the handbook reaffirms the gravity and solemnity of the celebrant's role and the necessity of leading a given service effectively.
