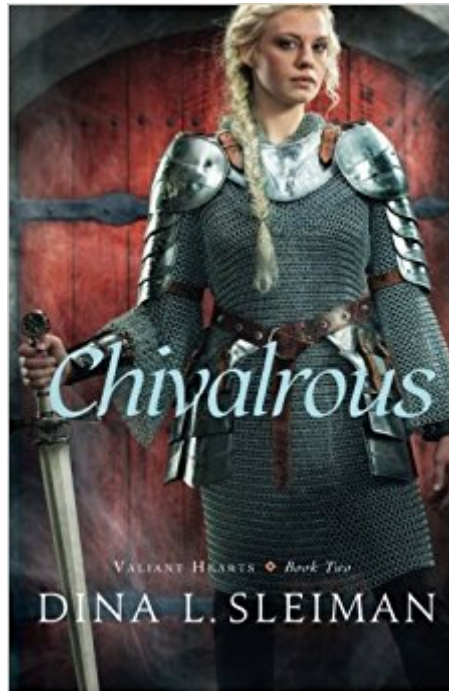




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Chivalrous (Valiant Hearts)

Under the guise of "Sir Geoffrey Lachapelle", she enters a local tournament and finds herself facing the handsome Sir Allen of Ellsworth, whose superb fighting abilities ultimately surpass her own, regardless of the fact that no one has ever heard of him. Interestingly enough, when Gwendolyn and Allen face each other without their armor, it becomes quite clear that sparring is the last thing on either of their minds. Newly knighted Allen of Ellsworth has travelled a great distance to the place where he feels that God has called him. Fleeing the vestiges of a failed romance, he never expected to be drawn to the lovely Lady Gwendolyn upon first sight. Unfortunately, tragedy soon occurs within Edendale and Allen's sense of pride, honor and integrity faces a much greater challenge than his feelings for Gwendolyn. Can he possibly let go of love in order to save an entire kingdom? Written against a backdrop of cruelty, rivalry and sinister intents; chivalry must rise to a new level in order for Allen, Gwendolyn to survive a treasonous interloper. A nicely written addition to Dina Sleiman's "Valiant Hearts" series, "Chivalrous" is infested with a multitude of twists and turns for two fiercely noble hearts to navigate.

Chivalrous, by Dina Sleiman, was lovely. It's all about Gwyn, a woman who wants to be herself but is stifled by her parents and her society, and Allen, a common man who is elevated to a position he never desired. Both are thrown into betrothals they don't want but try to make the best of the situation, even as they fall in love with one another. They struggle with their situation, misguided leaders, and social roles on top of the political turmoil of invaders and murder. And did I mention domestic abuse? Gwyn's father is a volatile ogre who believes women must completely submit. Themes of domestic abuse, social roles, misguided

leaders, and abortion give the sweet romance needed depth and twist the plot. I truly enjoyed Chivalrous and would recommend it to lovers of YA Historical Romance with a strong female protagonist.

It, of course, takes a woman to bring it back to the fore. Sure, Sleiman's heroes are dashing, her nobles brave and her Arthurian fluent, but what could be more glorious than a woman in armour? A love story so rife with intrigue, fraught with danger and tangled in emotion (plus Merry & the Ghosts of Farthingale Forest making an appearance that cannot be missed) that only the Lord's grace could set it back on course! I highly suggest reading with baited breath to find out if Allen finally gets the girl (and which one????) or whether Gwennie is finally delivered from her father's evil tyranny!
