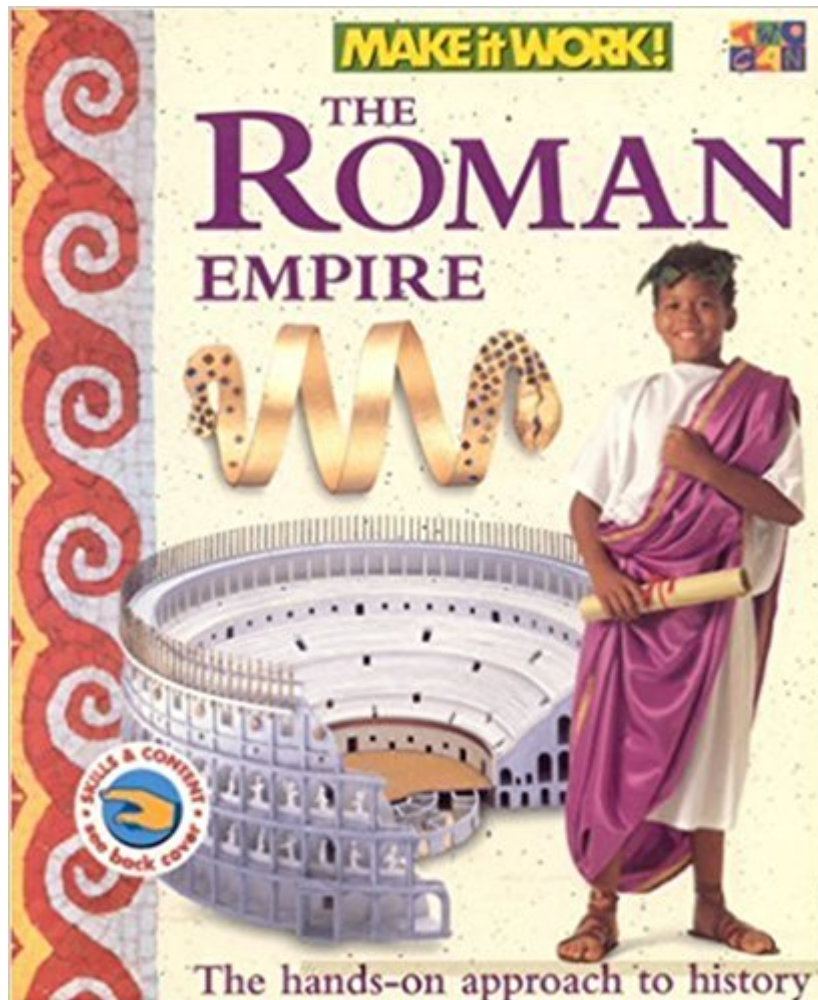




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Roman Empire (Make It Work! History)
