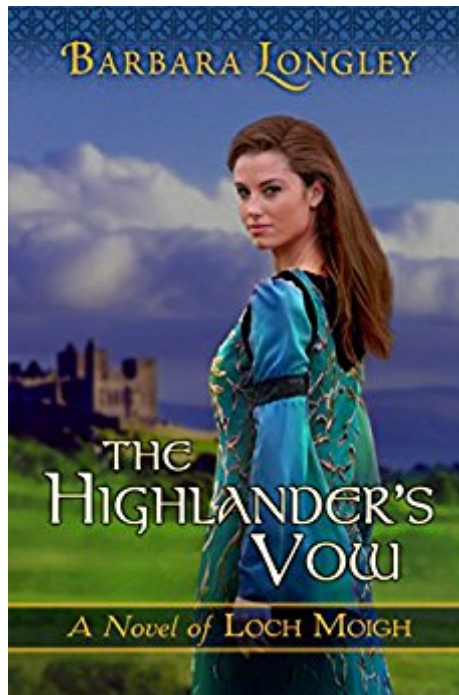


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The Highlander's Vow (The Novels Of Loch Moigh Book 4)

I love the Loch Moigh Time Travel series by Barbara Longley. Book 4 is the story of Sky Elizabeth Mackintosh eldest daughter of the Earl of Fife, which we meet in bk 1. After over hearing a plot to murder her by her betroth Sir Oliver of Clan Erskine and his lover Lady Alice Lunsden. Sky flees

from castle Kildrummy to find her father and brother to them that she won't marry Sir Oliver and about the plot to marry her just for her handsome diary. Then murder her. Sky flees right into the time travel portal and finds herself in 2014 at the New York Renaissance Fair's jousting field. She is laying at the feet of a Straun the illegitimate son of the 4th Earl of Sutherland. At the age of 14 Straun had been catapulted into the future from the year 1333. So he knows immediately what Skys sudden appearance means. Straun has been raised by the Gordon family and looks on them as his parents and there children as his brothers and sisters. They make excellent secondary characters to this fast moving emotional story. The question is how does Sky get back to her time in order to stop a war? Her disappearance will be considered as a broken betrothal causing a clan war between the Mackintosh's and the Erskines. Ms. Longley doesn't mince words by adding fillers to her story. She writes well thought out fast paced funny and romantic time travel stories. The Highlander Vow's is a great addition to this series. I fell in love with al the characters. Very good lighthearted romance between Straun and Sky!!

This time a Scottish lady named Sky accidentally comes to the future, and in an interesting twist, she falls from the portal directly into the path of Struan, who also came from the past, albeit from a time even earlier than hers. I love the conflict between these two. She's desperate to travel back to her own time to stop a war between clans, while he never wants to go back. He barely escaped death the last time he came through a portal, and he fears fate may aright itself if he travels through time again. He tries to convince her to stay in the future, but Sky is determined. As Struan comes to care for Sky more and more, he wants a relationship with her, but the odds are against him. If she returns to the past without him, he'll lose her and she'll likely be in danger. And if he travels back in time with her, he can protect her, but as a bastard son of a Laird, he won't be fit to wed a lady like Sky. This story was lots of fun and contained oodles of adventure. Loved it!

This was a riveting, impossible book to put down. Now that it is finished, I am sad. Excellent writing and character development. Very like able characters and you feel like you are right there in the story- not watching from the outside. I give very few five star reviews- a book has to be very
