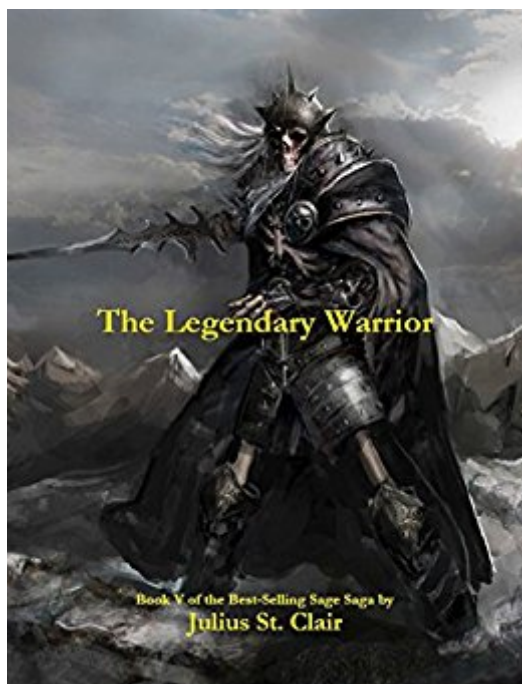


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The Legendary Warrior (Book #5 Of The Sage Saga)

Everyone is fighting to sway Bastion to their side. Meanwhile Catherine seeks to find out if the threat from the Yama is real or not. Bastion is at odds with his feelings and actions. He hopes to just be a normal teenager, but that seems to be impossible. The Legendary Warrior was an adequate addition to the Sage Saga. The Sage Saga is losing steam for me and I felt like I forced my way through this book. The characters have mainly stopped behaving like themselves by this edition. Catherine has

turned into a character where the ends justify the means. James has taken a dark path in order to save Allay and hates himself for it. Bastion seems like a robot learning to be a real boy. The others really don't feel all that important. A lot of questions that have gone unanswered since the first trilogy are answered in The Legendary Warrior. That was probably the best part of the book for me. There were also a few new plot twists that have peaked my interest. The characters have lost their luster, but I still intend on finishing the trilogy. 2.5 out of 5 stars

I think Mr. St Clair is mixing up or misplacing notes. Earlier in the series, when out looking for the 5 stones of power, Arimus loses one arm. In the next book he had 2 arms once again (I chocked it up to the healing qualities/abilities of the sages). In this book he is down to one arm once again and this time loses the last arm. He is still alive but did he heal or is he now going to be armless? The main characters continue to grow and discover where their powers lie and just how much power they find within themselves. We also learn just how deep the power runs in Bastion and at what cost to himself this power creates as it rises leaving us with the question of whether or not he will be able to contain/control this power in the last book in the series. I have greatly enjoyed the story told and will be sad when it all ends. Mr. St Clair has brought us a wonderful story with wonderful lively characters.

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
