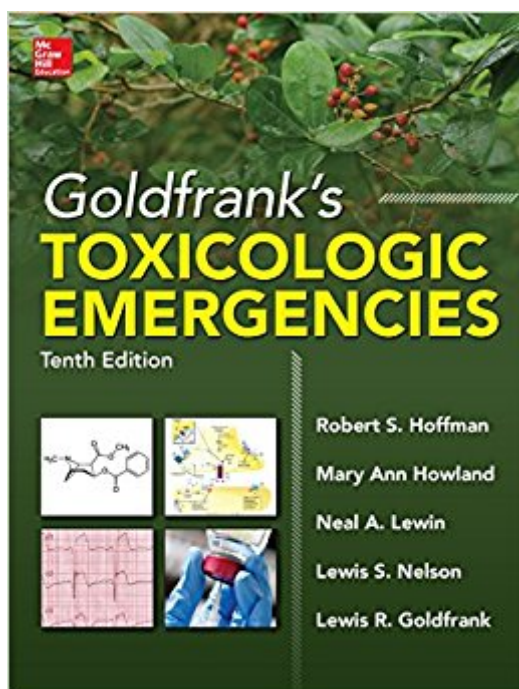

Nice textbook for resident in emergency department. However, the kindle edition has to refine two things to get 5 stars. First, table of contents couldn't show chapters in part B & C, which makes access to chapter 12~141 nothing more than nightmare. Second, the Index is a product of copy and paste from non-kindle edition, which means that you could see the Index page to page on Kindle, instead of searching the key words, so searching certain topic through Index would be the last thing

one will do on kindle. By the way, the numbers in Index are for solid book (page, in a real book) rather than for kindle (loc, in Kindle format) . One could say that it's an Index to puzzle, not Index to this great textbook. Unless you decide to read Goldfrank just like read a fiction novel, page-to-page and front-to-back, the Kindle edition should be the last choice for whom interesting to Toxicology. Quite regret to buy this great book in kindle edition.
