

Sybil combines her lifelong love of prayer with her experience as a community college mathematics professor to offer workshops and retreats throughout the U.S. and Canada. Her workshops, both prayerful and playful, engage people of varied learning styles. Sybil is married to Andy MacBeth, an Episcopal priest, and is the mother of two adult sons. “Praying in Color” has been translated into Spanish, Italian and Korean. Her 2014 book “The Season of the Nativity: Confessions and Practices of an Advent, Christmas, and Epiphany Extremist” (Paraclete Press, Fall 2014) invites people to experience the richness of the holiday season at home. Another beautiful book from Sybil MacBeth, the best-selling author of the “Praying in Color” books. For those who have read and enjoyed her books this is a perfect book to continue your journey on coloring, doodling and prayer. There are 6 chapters and 32 pages with templates for coloring including ideas for Advent and Lent calendars. The chapters include: Coloring as a Spiritual Practice, Coloring as Prayer, The Coloring Pages/Templates, Preparing to Pray, Ways to Pray, and Prayer + Coloring + Doodling = Praying in Color. The best way to describe this book are from words from the author herself: “This book is for people who...struggle with prayer, never thought to combine prayer and coloring, have trouble finding words for their prayers, want a new way to pray, like to color but feel inadequate about their drawing or doodling skills, like to color even though they have sophisticated drawing and technical skills, have never colored, want to find a way to incorporate their hands and eyes into prayer...” and more. The chapters give you examples, explanations, ideas, how-to and encouragement. I’m so happy I purchased this book! It is also a nice change and complement to biblical adult coloring books. There is another book (“Count Your Blessings in Color”) by Ms. MacBeth that is coming out late November that I am also looking forward to.

I love this book! I have Sybil MacBeth's other books, including her *Praying in Color*. I discovered Sybil's books on . This "Coloring Book" is a great way to introduce drawing, doodling, and coloring into your prayer life. It is a way to pray when you don't know exactly what to pray for. The book comes with instructions and suggestions for improving your prayer life by incorporating illustrations, writing and drawing. You can use the pre-done illustrations to add names, subjects, and color. She has details on her website and Facebook page if you want more information. I highly recommend this as a useful book and a great gift!
