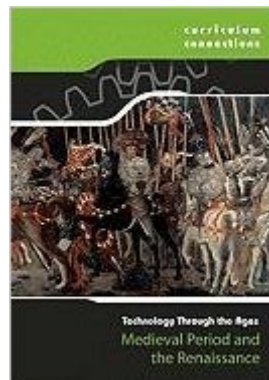

Titles in the Technology through the Ages series trace the history of scientific innovation from prehistoric ages to the modern world. Spanning a time period from AD 0 to 1625, this volume packs an enormous amount of information into brief chapters that take a welcome global view. Detailed sections discuss Chinese and Arabian advancements that developed while Europe was still mired in the Dark Ages. Designed to provide direct curriculum support, the pages feature highlighted links to state and national science standards. With so much covered in such a brief space, topics are inevitably glossed over, but focused sidebars on subjects such as Viking navigation and Gutenberg's press allow for more elaboration, and an extended time line will help readers put each innovation into context. The selection of artists' renderings, archival reproductions, and color photos of ancient ruins add interest to the clear but dry text. Useful for students seeking historical review or inspiration for research topics, this will leave readers
