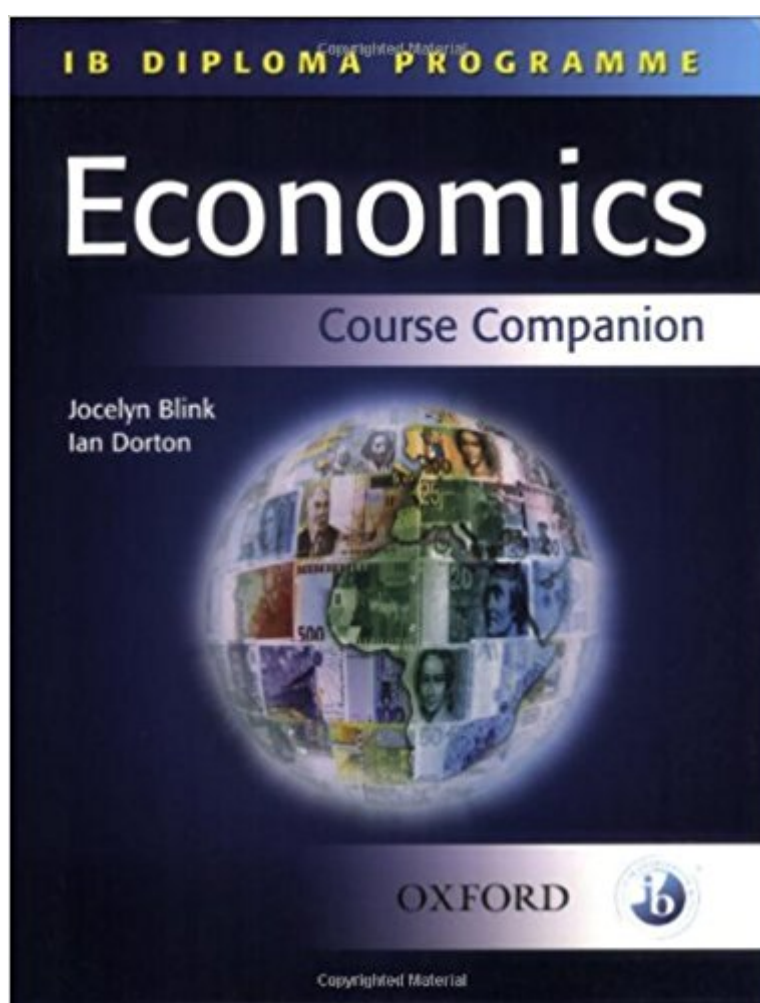


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IB Economics Course Companion: International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (International Baccalaureate Course Companions)
