

Robert S. Feldman is Professor of Psychological and Brain Sciences and Deputy Chancellor of the University of Massachusetts, Amherst. A recipient of the College Distinguished Teacher Award, he teaches psychology classes ranging in size from 15 to nearly 500 students. During the course of more than three decades as a college instructor, he has taught both undergraduate and graduate courses at Mount Holyoke College, Wesleyan University, and Virginia Commonwealth University in addition to the University of Massachusetts. Professor Feldman, who initiated the Minority Mentoring Program at the University of Massachusetts, also has served as a Hewlett Teaching Fellow and Senior Online Teaching Fellow. He initiated distance learning courses in psychology at the University of Massachusetts. A Fellow of the American Psychological Association, the Association for Psychological Science, and the American Association for the Advancement of Science, Professor Feldman received a B.A. with High Honors from Wesleyan University (from which he received the Distinguished Alumni Award). He has an MS and Ph.D. from the University of Wisconsin-Madison. He is a winner of a Fulbright Senior Research Scholar and Lecturer award, and he has written more than 100 books, book chapters, and scientific articles. He has edited Development of Nonverbal Behavior in Children (Springer-Verlag) and Applications of Nonverbal Behavioral Theory and Research (Erlbaum), and co-edited Fundamentals of Nonverbal Behavior (Cambridge University Press). He is also author of Child Development, Understanding Psychology, and P.O.W.E.R. Learning: Strategies for Success in College and Life. His books have been translated into many languages, including Spanish, French, Portuguese, Dutch, Chinese, Korean, German, Arabic, and Japanese. His research interests include honesty and deception in everyday life, work that he described in The Liar in Your Life, a trade book published in 2009. His research has been supported by grants from the National Institute of Mental Health and the National Institute on Disabilities and Rehabilitation Research. Professor Feldman is president of the Federation of Associations of Behavioral and Brain Sciences Foundation, a consortium of societies that benefit the social sciences. In addition, he is on the Board of New England Public Radio. Professor

Feldman loves music, is an enthusiastic pianist, and enjoys cooking and traveling. He has three children, four grandchildren, and he and his wife, a psychologist, live in western Massachusetts in a home overlooking the Holyoke Mountain Range.

This book was priced at an astoundingly low price of \$15.43, a major difference from the \$255.70 to buy, and \$227.00 to rent, that my campus bookstore is charging. It's hard enough to pay for the extra fees without having to pay a fortune on books. I am usually a very tough critic when it comes to purchasing things and I expect everything to be in order if I am going to spend money on it. Before I review let me say this, this is just the book MyPsychLab is NOT included with this purchase, nor is there an Access code in the book. My class required only the book. We do not need any Pearson software, my professor does not use it. So if you need the Pearson software, you should buy a NEW BOOK which usually contains the software. I was weary about buying a book that was so cheap and kept thinking "it has to be in the worst possible condition, but hey I am still going to use it because I need the book." I am so happy that I was wrong! The book I received is in excellent condition given it is used. There was minor folds of the corner pages just in the index (2-3 pages max) minor inward folding on the front cover (to be expected because hey backpacks do that sort of thing). Minimal and I mean MINIMAL highlighting or marks in the page. No bright pink highlights or lime green.....lightest yellow highlights possible. Any marks in my book are used sparingly and are so few. The binding is solid and not coming apart and all pages are there. Anyhow I feel that I made a great purchase here and I saved a lot of money by doing so. \$240.27 to be exact.

This book came in good condition. It was an easy read. My class was all online, so I just sat in front of my computer with this book during tests, quizzes, and assignments. I was able to flip through the book easily to find the information needed to ace the class.

Please, please make sure that you talk to your instructor before purchasing this book to see if you need an access key with the book. This book DOES NOT automatically come with the access key. The access key is a code that you enter online to gain online access to all of the additional resources that the class has to offer, which is called the Development Lab. My professor did not use the Development Lab in her lectures so this book was perfect for me! However, if you need the key, it is probably going to be cheaper to purchase it all together, as a set. Otherwise, I did see where was selling the access key for \$40, which was still cheaper than what my school was selling it for. I

read the other reviews prior to purchasing this book and it seems as though this is where people were the most frustrated with purchasing this book. So, make sure you talk to your professor first! This truly is an awesome text! Very well written, easy to follow!

I bought this book for a class I am taking at community college, and I found that everywhere I looked charged an arm and a leg for this book (ouch!) So I ordered it from this seller and out of my surprise, it was nearly fifty dollars cheaper than anywhere else I could find this item, and it was practically brand new. Part of the spine at the top was ripped, but it was hardly noticeable. The pages were all in tact, there was no writing or highlighting, and I am able to use it efficiently in class. This is a great buy without having to go broke.
