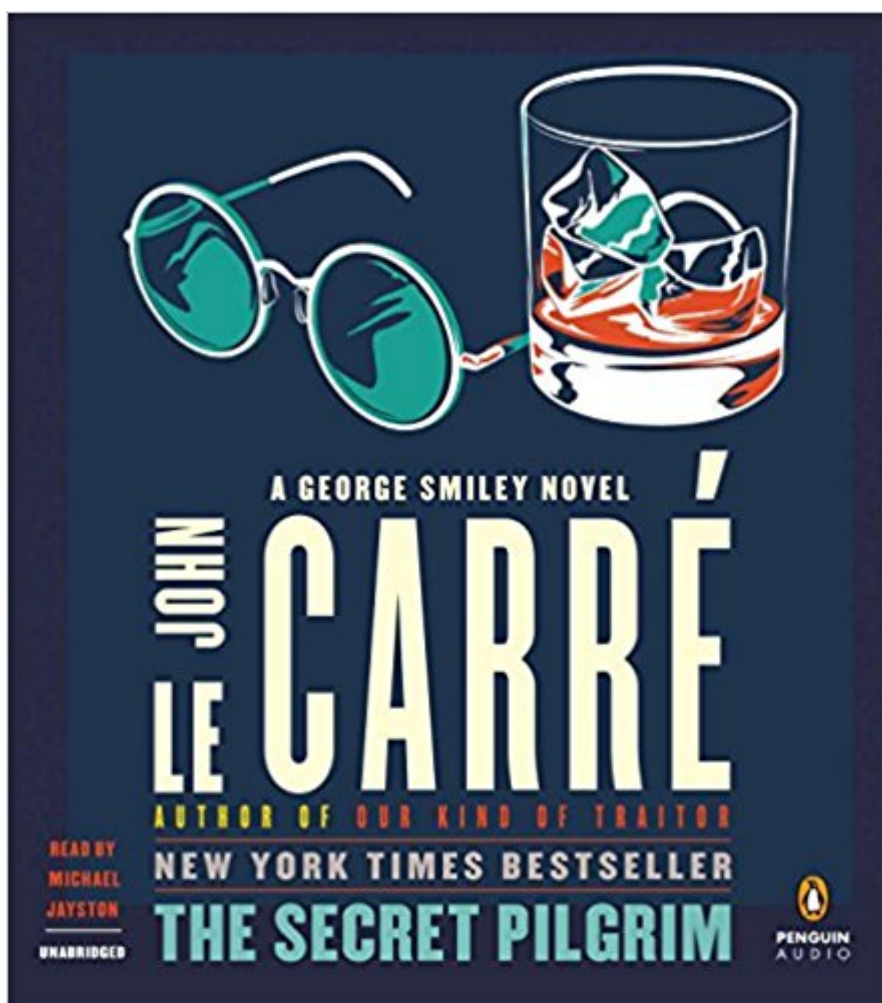

Michael Jayston is a
