


The book was found

maid escapes with him. Then the story moves forward where Nathaniel is older, he became a pirate to bait his fathers shipping fleet. He then comes up with a plan to kidnap his half-sister. With some confusion he kidnaps a seamstress instead of his sister. There is an attraction between Alexandra and Nathaniel, she tells him she is not his sister and even though he is attracted to her he does not believe her completely although he has doubts. As they are in his cabin on his ship the space is cramped and she can't help but feel something for him. Because of the attraction she plays hot and cold on being his sister as she feels that she would be safe from the crew if they think she is his sister. When Nathaniel captures Jake the truth comes out. But Alexandra wants a husband and children and Nathaniel does not believe that he can give her that. I admired the fact that she fell in love with him even though he only had one arm and she saw him without a shirt. When I thought the story would be ending I still had 50% of the book left. Then all the twists and turns with his father start. A good book.

Pros: Better than average writing, although "ahold" is not a word in my dictionary. Interesting plot twists among standard "perils of Pauline" events. Final denouement was a surprise to me. Cons: The "almost sex scenes" are more distasteful than erotic. That the hero is attracted to a woman he believes is his half sister is not really the issue because he is horrified by the attraction and fights against it. There are two or three almost sexual assaults. Also in the beginning, Nathaniel is remarkably cruel towards someone he is planning to use merely as a pawn. He seems inconsistent. Perhaps I just like to have my heroes more heroic.

The author draws you in and makes you feel right at home as the picture is painted...commoners and nobles, those forgotten and those whom they wanted to forget. His grace wanted perfection, but actions cause a series of events...all things loved he lost... The things he hated stood tall and triumphed. Awesome read!

While I enjoyed the story of Alexandra and Nathaniel, I must say that after convincing me of the magnetic pull between the two, I was left wanting. I wanted the undeniable attraction to be consummated. It never was. So, if you like some actual steam created by your romance couples, this book will not oblige, other than kissing and breast fondling. The story did hold my interest and the writing was flowed well. There were times when circumstances seemed too contrived for my liking. Also, to have a snitch who is named Rat was too much. But, I did like the main characters. I particularly liked Alexandra who had a strong inner character, was resourceful, and kind to others.

Another great story by Brenda Novak, action, emotion, unique and kept me turning the pages. Believe this was her first 'Historical Romance', I have loved reading them all, 4 to date and all are 5 stars, hope she writes more.
