

I bought this for my 77 year old mother and she is thrilled with it. She has been crocheting for a long time and she was afraid that these patterns might be the same ones that she has already done, but

she was thrilled to find that the majority of them were new patterns for her.

Love the vintage crochet books and they are getting harder and harder to find. This is not really for beginners, but if you know how to crochet or want to expand your knowledge, this book is great. The patterns use stitches like "long trebles", 5 times over the hook, instead of the basic chain stitch in some of the patterns, but they are beautiful when done. Make sure you use the required size of thread though as some of these are made with very small. Fantastic addition to my "library".

It is a really cool book. It has many beautiful models. However, if you like to crochet using the charts, this is not the book for you, because only 2 models out from over 20 have charts. If you understand the written crochet patterns, then it is the book for you! I understand both types of patterns charts and written patterns, so it works for me.
