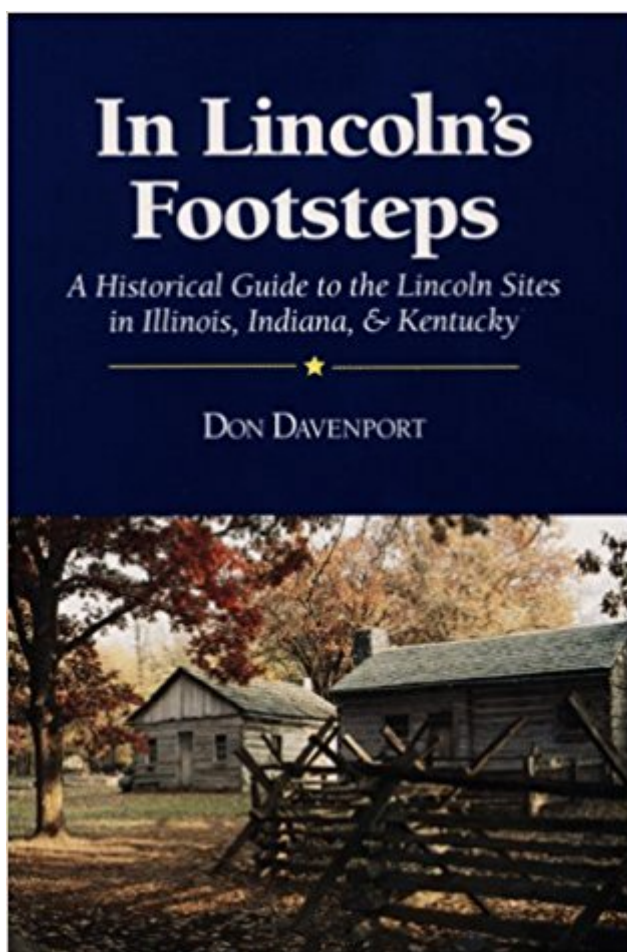

As Mr. Davenport stated in that edition, the book is a travel guide, not a biography.
