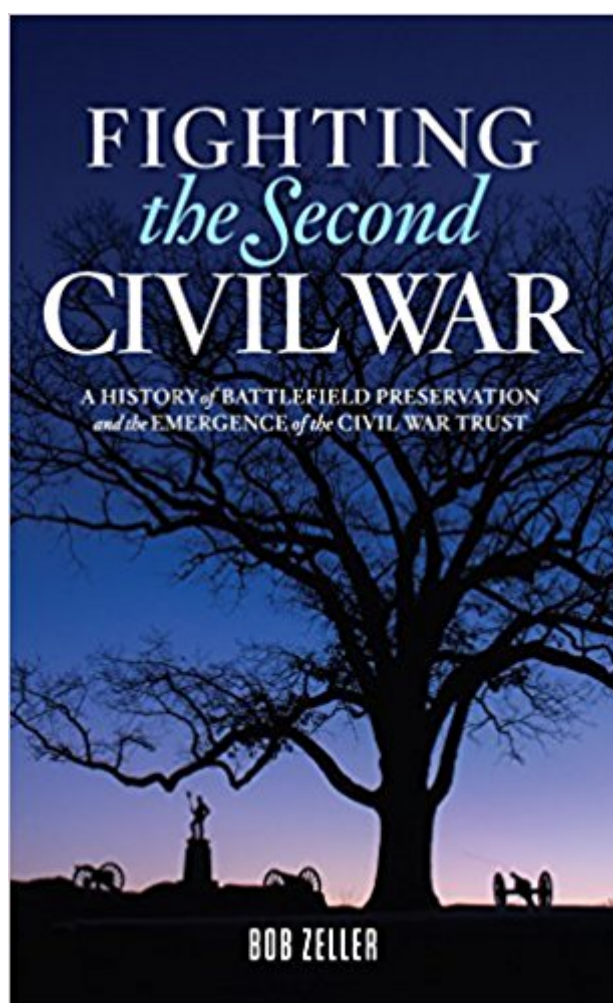

This work is like a stroll down memory lane for those of us old enough to be involved in supporting battlefield preservation over the last thirty years. Mr. Zeller has organized the book both topically

(e.g. chapters on Franklin and Brandy Station) and chronologically, which could have been very confusing but actually works quite well. His insight into the drama involving the merger of APCWS and the original CWT reads like something off the pen of Tom Wolfe. Bravo!
