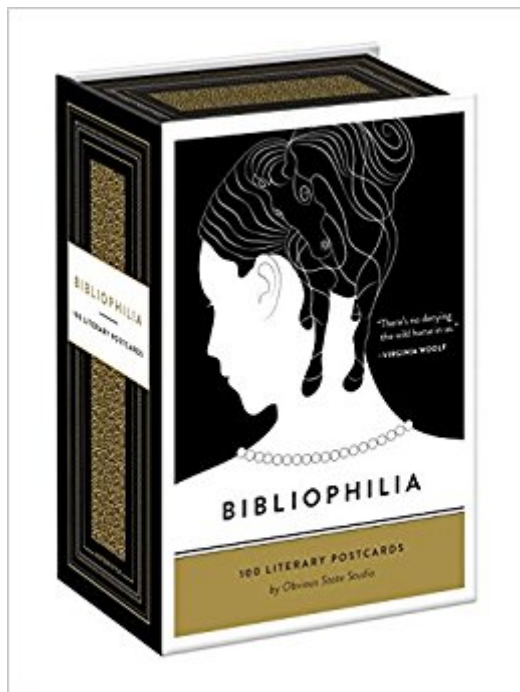

Evan Robertson is an illustrator the Co-founder of Obvious State - a New York City-based design studio inspired by literature and language. They're word lovers who make things for fellow word lovers.

Okay, I REALLY like the simplicity of the cards. In their own way, I find them elegantly done and in incredible good taste. The card stock is of high quality, there are 2 sets of 50, which has been a common occurrence with 100 card box sets as of late, and the quotes chosen are all fairly well known and would be easily recognizable to most readers. My ONLY complaint is that I wish there were literature quotes of the later 20th century. While I am fond of the classics, it would have been nice to have a wider variety of literary influences. Also, a few done in more vibrant colors would have been a nice touch. BUT, postcard preferences are subjective - still a great purchase and will use them all!

I purchase postcards frequently, and these are some of the best I've ever bought. The cards are

thick and sturdy, the finish is glossy, and the illustrations are phenomenal. The quotations also aren't the typical ones used for each author, I love the originality. I also love that there are 2 sets of 50 designs - I didn't realize it initially and didn't want to send any out! But now I can share with my friends and still keep a set for myself. Love this!

Great set! there are 2 of each kind. Great for readers. A good mix of complex and more simple quotes.

Awesome, high quality post cards! As far as I can tell, two copies of each different graphic/quote, but that still offers a TON of variety. Will keep my slightly old-fashioned preference for written correspondence alive just that much longer.

These are fantastic little post cards - and worth every penny. They're thick and glossy, with good sized writing space on the back. I use them for everything - a quick note to a friend, thank you notes, get well cards -- my daughter chose a bunch and gave them as graduation cards for her friends last year. This is a fabulous collection, with something for everyone. I will likely order it again.

Great graphic images and literary quotes. Purchased for Postcrossing exchanges overseas, the cards are well printed on heavy stock, and I'm sure will entertain the recipients as much as they do me.

Love these! My English-major daughter and I spent a wonderful evening with these by covering up the author's name at the bottom of each card and trying to guess the writer. The artwork is great - generally spare but conveying several layers of meaning.
