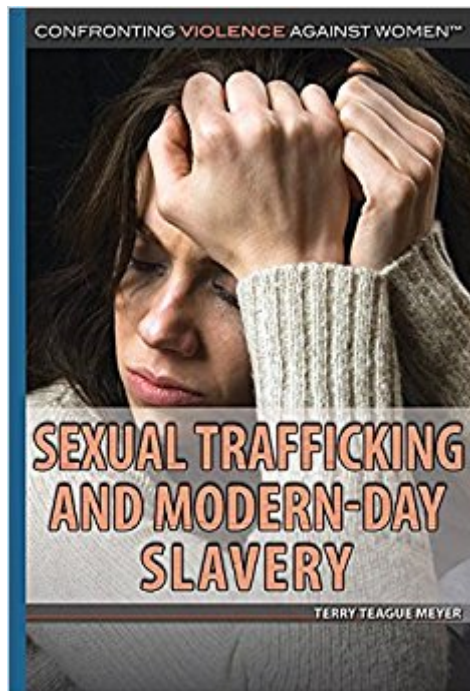




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Sexual Trafficking And Modern-Day Slavery (Confronting Violence Against Women)
