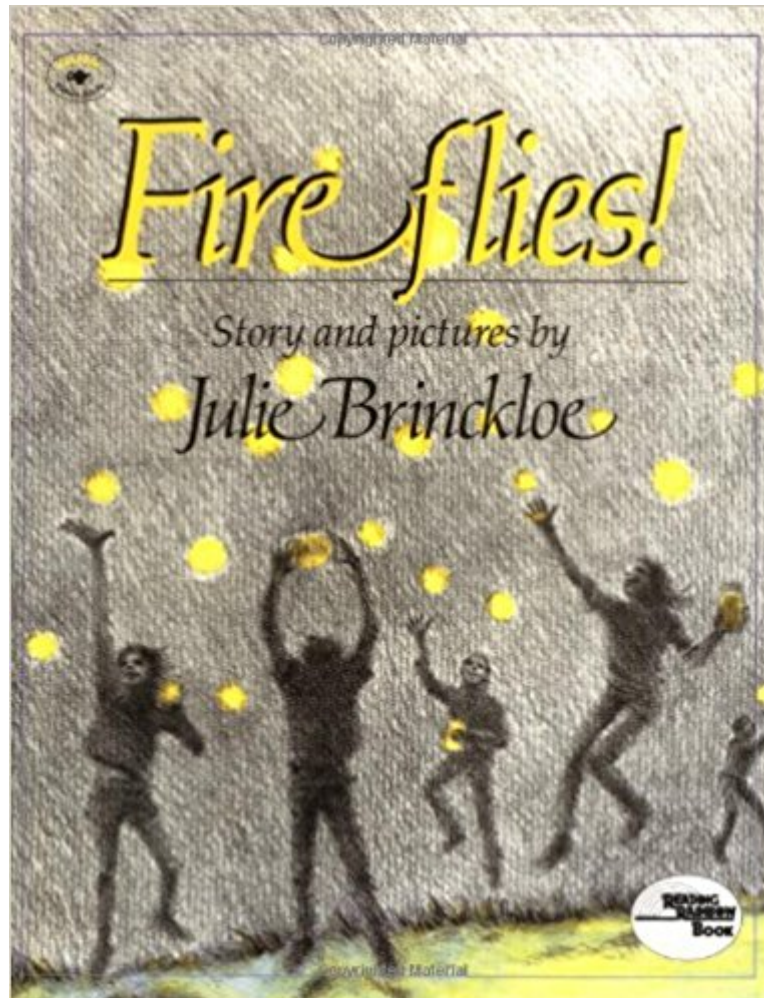

A sweet story. As a teacher, I can imagine using this in my middle-school classroom to discuss storytelling with students. For elementary teachers, this would be a lovely story to read as the year winds down and the lightning bugs light up!

I teach 2nd grade and this is the perfect story for comparing fiction with non-fiction about fireflies. I use it for discussing habitat and needs for living creatures as well. I have also used it to discuss how a character's feelings change over the course of a story. The illustrations are unique with the black and white sketch style highlighted with only the yellow of the fire flies. Beautiful story and life lesson. The reading level is great for read aloud as well as guided reading groups.

Reminded me of my youth in Ontario, Canada! I wanted to introduce my grandkids who live in BC to these amazing beetles. They have never seen them! This is a great little book dealing with the wish

of all children to catch these "flashing lights" in an old mason jar, and subsequently realizing that they are their best when left where nature intended them. I found a glow in the dark "Firefly t-shirt" to go along with the book!
