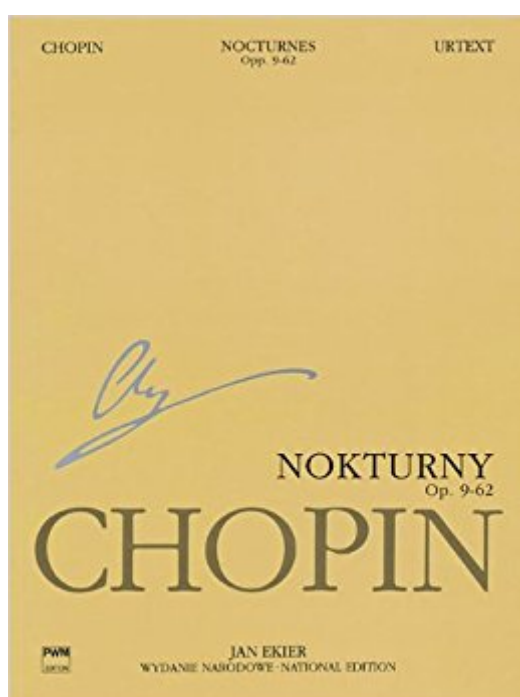


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This is a great book, and this edition is better than Padereski!

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
