Great book with lots of high resolution pictures of a line of phenomenal Lego-constructed mechs! Truly inspires readers to build with Legos. The level of creativity displayed in these models is stunning. I was amazed over and over how he turned standard Lego parts into entirely new functions as part of a mech, and in such a way as made them feel like they really belonged in that place. My only complaint with the book, and it's not enough to lose even a part of a star over, is that the pictures all approach the models as completed works of art (which they are). I would have loved to have seen an additional page or two at the end of each mech deconstructing one or two of the

signature parts into their Lego components, just to give us more inspiration on how these were constructed. There are so many places that I can look at the parts and tell they are Lego, but can't tell what parts or how it was built to give that specific look - it would be nice to get some hits as to how he made them. Again, an amazing display of ingenuity captured in a series of pictures I'm sure our family will spend countless hours pouring over. Highly recommended!

I've been a fan of Waka's Lego mecha for a while, following his creations on the web. This little book is a great selection of minifig-scale mecha, that should please anyone interested in seeing well crafted Lego. There isn't any text, but the pictures are superb, and I know that I'll be mining them for inspiration and ideas for my own creations. The book is short, but the price is fair. You'll also want to view it on a full-color screen. Enjoy!
