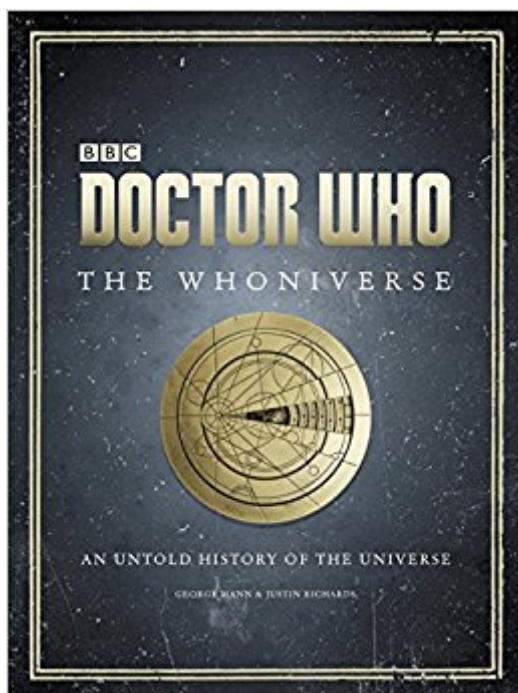

Justin Richards has written for stage and screen as well as novels and graphic novels. He writes extensively for children and has also co-authored several action thrillers for young adults with the acknowledged master of the genre, Jack Higgins. The first two novels in his adult science fiction Never War series, *The Suicide Exhibition* and *The Blood Red City*, were published in 2013 and 2014, respectively. Justin acts as creative consultant to BBC Books' Doctor Who titles, and he has penned quite a few himself. Married with two children (both boys), Justin lives and works in Warwick, England, within sight of one of Britain's best-preserved castles.

Doctor Who: The Whoniverse: The Untold History of Space and Time is simply fantastic! I had pre-ordered the book and received it right on the day it was released. I have devoured parts of the book already and my inner geek loves it! You know how some companion books are simply a rehash of old materials? Sometimes it doesn't seem worth it to buy a new book just for a new cover and a different arrangement of information from past books. Well, let me tell you that this one is different. First, the illustrations are beautiful and the book itself is well made. Instead of plain white, the pages are colored to give it an aged look. The book is organized into seven chapters: the early universe, the birth of knowledge, the age of expansion, the rise of the cybermen, the age of empire, the time of the daleks, and the end of time. It certainly is one of the most interesting history books I've had the pleasure of reading. Any Doctor Who fan would love it.
