

I found that she could make great examples over ideas that would not normally be considered a normal sex scene. I mean not many of us think about a male strip tease being something of the romance novels, unless you just came back from Thunder Down Under, but this book certainly brought it to the fore front of my mind. With that said I felt that it really more or less just highlighted the author's sex scenes instead of how to really create and inspire your own Love scenes. She does say she is

writing what she knows and lord knows we are all trying to do that, but it was a bit of a plug for her novels, which are for the most part paranormal and would not work for the mainstream romance. Over all I felt that this was worth the read and the relatively inexpensive price and if nothing else it allowed me to stretch my ideas of where and how a sexy scene can take place. I would recommend it for the more well read self help indie romance writer, who has tried the others and needs a new spin.
